The camp is offered in weekly sessions from Monday to Friday. The camp begins at 9:00am and runs until 4:00pm. However, if these hours are inconvenient to you please contact the camp for additional hours of service.

Location of Rouge Beach Camp Site:

The Rouge Beach Park is located at the mouth of the Rouge River on Lake Ontario. We are located on the border of Scarborough (West Hill) and Pickering. **Travelling from Scarborough**, follow Lawrence Ave. E. about 1.5 km east of the Rouge Hill GO Station. When Lawrence Ave. meets Rouge Hills Drive enter into the Rouge Beach by going through the gates and down the hill into the parking lot. We are located around the corner when walking under the train bridge. **Travelling from Ajax**, follow either Rosebank Rd. S. or Rougemount Rd. to Dyson. Follow Dyson to the end. Please park your car at the end of the road on the parking side of the road only. Follow the walking path over the bridge and go toward Lake Ontario. We are located in the trailer, on the beach, south of the railway bridge.

CIT PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The CIT program has been created to provide a valuable week-long learning experience for campers aged 13-16 years old. CITs will assist camp staff by helping and participating in the following activities:

- Actively participating in camp games and programming
- Helping campers with daily activities on water and on land (No previous paddling experience is necessary – we will teach you everything you need to know!)
- Reporting of inappropriate behaviour or physical safety issues by campers to camp staff

The goal of the CIT program is to provide individuals with the opportunity to work with children in a camp setting, while having the support and supervision of experienced camp staff. Every morning before joining their camper group, CITs will spend time learning about effective communication, responsibility, valuable leadership skills and teamwork. They will then be able to actively practice these skills while working with the campers and camp staff.

By passing the program, CITs will receive 25 hours of community service. To pass the program, CITs will be required to show appropriate levels of maturity, responsibility, and enthusiasm. CITs will receive a rubric of expectations on their first day of camp to ensure the understanding of their roles. After successful completion of the program, we would be happy to provide reference letters for future employment or volunteering positions.

Although CITs will be given a position of authority, they will be expected to model appropriate behaviour such as respectful communication, water safety and positive participation.

We hope that this program will provide an exciting learning opportunity for individuals interested in childcare, sport, and leadership.
